All reports shall be titled by office, dated as to the date reported and typed in third person on letter-sized (8 1/2" x 11") white paper. Reports should have a 1 1/2" left margin (no staples, punched holes, or stationary acceptable). Reports should be signed in ink by the State Officer or Chair and corresponding Senior and produced in triplicate. Copies due to: Senior State President, Senior State Secretary and the person who succeeds to the office. [Standing Rule #2]
